Please pay the entry fees only after you online when you will receive a mail with the necessary information for payment. Be sure to include the variable symbol! Every entry form must include a clearly readable copy of dog's pedigree. Any other documents ((puppy card, registers, etc.) will be accepted only for Minor Puppy class! You will find all the needed payment data (bank account, amount to pay and a variable symbol) with your sent entry form in the entry form, or on webpage www.skchr.sk. It is compulsory to pay the entry fee = bank transfer on the day, but no later than 24 hours after submitting the entry. Unpaid entries are automatically cancelled after 3 days without prior notice. For payments from abroad please mention variable symbol in the message – information to the recipient. After second deadline, you will receive an entry confirmation.

CLASSES:

	g to the class, the decisive age of the dog is the age on the day of the show)
PET class	from 3 months (for all pet dogs with pedigree)
Minor puppy class	from 3 to 6 months
Puppy class	from 6 to 9 months
Junior class	from 9 to 18 months
Intermediate class	from 15 to 24 months
Open class	from 15 months, it is accessible to all dogs regardless to passed working exams or achieved championships
Working class	from15 months, it is accessible to all dogs with a working certificate issued by SPZ
Champion class	from 15 months, it is accessible to all dogs which obtained title C.I.B or champion title from any member country of FCI
Veteran class	from 8th year
Honorary class	out of competition, in this class you can show dogs without qualification with awarding marks and ranking. Accessible to all dogs with recognized national or international champion title, the title of national winner, club winner, specialty winner or champion SKCHR. Listed titles shall be obtained in adult competition. Dogs in this class are shown without claim titles and championships.

TITLES AND CERTIFICATES:

There is no pretension for any of the titles – the judges have the right not to award any of the titles. A judge is obliged to disqualify aggressive dogs. CAC / res. BEST PUPPY - title can be awarded to the best male or female in the puppy class in competition very

BOB – Best of breed - the Specialty show Young Winner, the Specialty show Winner and winners of the veteran class in competition excellent 1 will compete for BOB

BOS – Best opposite sex - the winners of opposite sex of BOB will compete for BOS

- **BOV Best veteran** title can be awarded to the best male or female in the veteran class in competition excellent 1
- **BOJ Best junior** title can be awarded to the best male or female in the junior class in competition excellent 1 CAJC

COMPETITIONS:

Entered dogs must been judged at Specialty show.

Best male / female from Slovak breeding – title can be awarded to the best male and female in the junior class with CAJC, intermedia, open, working and champion classes with CAC and honorary and veteran classes with Excelent 1, which come from kennels registered in Slovakia.

Child and dog / Junior Handling – Criteria being judged: teamwork of child and dog, synchronization and handling. Quality of the dog is not decisive. Handled dog have been judged at this show. Children to the age of 17 can enter this competition.

Best young head male / female – males and females less than 18 months old are judged separately, dog's head is judged in sitting position.

Best adult head male / female – males and females more than 15 months old are judged separately, dog's head is judged in sitting position.

Best ridge – Males and females are judged together. Dog's ridge is judged in sitting position.

Best movement – Males and females are judged together. Criteria being judged: quality, elegance and dynamics of movement with an emphasis on proper mechanics of movement.

Best couple – One owner can enter his/her male and female that have been judged at this show and are in same ownership, not a co-owner. Owner must be indicated in the pedigree.

Best breeder's group - A breeder can enter his/her breeder's group of min. 3 max. 5 dogs, which have been judged at this show. The dogs and bitches do not have to be owned by the breeder, but they must come from same kennel from at least two different litters, at least two different sires or dams. A dog can only be entered to one breeder's group. **Best stud dog -** The competition can be entered by enter the dog and at least 5 of his progeny, which have been judged

at this show. Criteria being judged: the type and the quality of progeny. Stud dog need to be judged at this show.

* If you are entering male/female to the baby, puppy or PET class and you are using your voucher "DARČEKOVÝ POUKAZ SKCHR NA VÝSTAVNÝ POPLATOK", don't forgot to submit this in entry form. If you are entering your male/female by online system, you have to inform organizer by mail vystavy@skchr.sk. The fee will be reduced. It is not required to send the voucher by post. The original is the owner obliged to submit at the club show during the presentation.

VETERINARY RULES

Every dog must have pet pass with valid vaccinations against rabies, distemper, parvovirus and hepatitis at least 21 days and a maximum 1 year before show, or according to duration of vaccine.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

The show is held under the FCI, SKJ and SKCHR show regulations. Dogs must be registered with the stud book in the country of residence of the owner or with the other stud book recognized by FCI.

By signing the application form exhibitor abides to all dog show rules. Exhibitor is responsible for all data written in application form.

By upload data to online system or signing the entry form exhibitor abides registered person to SKCHR consent to the processing of personal data - name, surname, address, tel. numbers and e-mail.

Upload entry form to online system or signing the form exhibitor abides to all dog show rules (FCI, SKJ, SKCHR) and veterinary rules. The exhibitor is giving his/her permission to publish his/her name and address in the exhibition catalog and on the website of the organizer as well as publishing pictures, results and reports from the exhibition according to the needs of the organizer and partners of the exhibition.

The exhibitor is required to pay all show fees.

Neither the show committee nor organizer take responsibility for a dog's illness, dog's loss or death and neither they take responsibility for damage caused by a dog or an exhibitor in the venue area. The owner is responsible for any damages caused by the dog. Should the show not be held for the unforeseen reasons, the exhibition fees will be used to cover the expenses.

It's possible to entry competitions and pay at the day of the show till 11:30 a.m. to the cashier. The amounts are as of the date of the 2_{nd} deadline. (member $5 \in$, non-member $10 \in$).

In case of high number of registered dogs of one owner to classes pet, minor puppy, puppy, veteran and honorary they are not considered for first registered dog. Discount for second and any additional dog can be applied only if name of the owner is fully consistent with registration of the first dog. The closing date is also the deadline for payment exhibition fees to the appropriate deadline. Cancellation of registration is allowed till 2nd deadline, also in case if it is prolonged. Change of class is also allowed till 2nd deadline, for a fee 5 €.

COMPLAINTS

Complaints against judge's decision are inadmissible. Only formal reasons of breaching the Exhibition Regulations or instructions may be contested. A complaint must be filed in written form together with a bail of 30€ during the exhibition only at the exhibition director.
